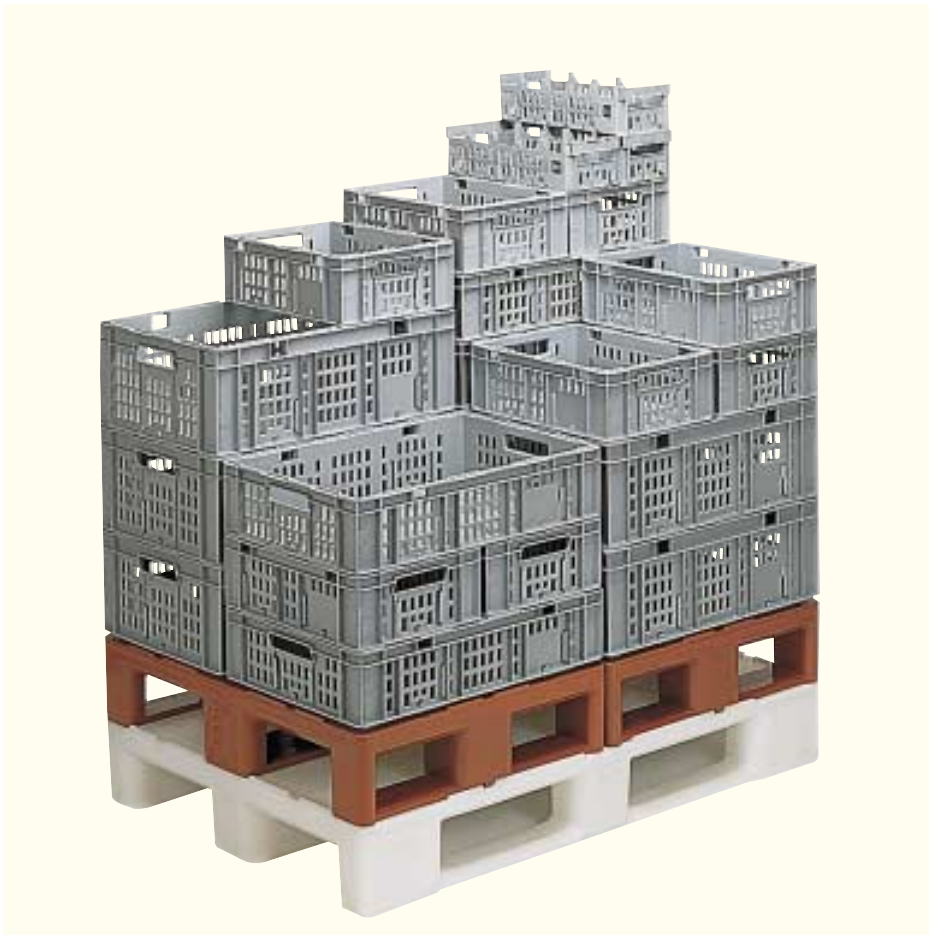

High-bay rackable Hygiene Pallets

The Utz High-bay rackable Hygiene-Pallet is made of superior plastic and totally enclosed making it a true hygiene pallet – with no restrictions. The version with runners and steel tube reinforcement can even be used in high-bay racking for evenly distributed loads of up to 1000 kg.

The special runner design ensures smooth, non-wearing travel on all commonly used automatic conveyor systems. The wide range of variants extends from bases with 3 runners or 9 feet to different upper deck types providing a non-slip surface for the goods being transported or stored. The following are available:

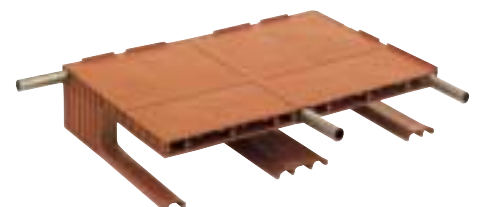
- EHI-compatible safety edge
- continuous safety edge
- recessed container location areas
- non-slip surface.

The pallets are available in Euro size (1200x800 mm), ISO size (1200x1000 mm) and as half-size pallets (800x600 mm). They all comply with the EHI requirements for hygiene pallets and meet pallet standard DIN 15141 as well as the SGL recommendations 120.01 and 120.05.

Benefits:

- no nails, no rusting
- non-rotting, impervious to mould
- rounded corners
- resistant to acids and alkalis
- dimensionally stable and temperature resistant
- consistent weight.

SGL Stacking Containers Bakery Containers



SGL containers have been employed to great success for many years as multiple-use containers in the foodstuffs industry. Their ruggedness, versatility and ease of washing make the containers a perfect transport and storage system for internal, hygienic production cycles.

Many foodstuffs manufacturers and finishers use the SGL containers (in conjunction with the Utz hygiene pallet) as a means of transport when products have to be delivered via a distribution store to the point of sale without repacking.

The two base sizes 600x400 mm and 400x300 mm can be stacked together securely. SGL containers offer many features:

- various walls and handle types
 - five different bases
- SGL 2000:
- integral label holder
 - slotted walls and bases
 - special bases for bakery requirements
 - yoghurt containers

The SGL Tower: Hygiene pallet and SGL Container

Not only must each element in the logistical value-creation chain be employed correctly, the individual elements must also perfectly match one another.

Pallets and containers are produced from food-grade plastic. In the foodstuffs industry they are subject to the most rigorous hygiene regulations. Right from the development phase, great importance was attached to achieving the smoothest possible surface thereby preventing the accumulation of dirt and in turn bacterial growth.

Containers and pallets stack together securely to form transport or storage units and are the epitome of a well-thought-out logistics system.

Pallet Boxes



The ISO size 1200x1000 mm is used for the Pallet Box. Its capacity of 600 litres makes it ideal for carrying almost anything bulky, unwieldy or liquid. Pallet Boxes are available in different versions enabling them to be adapted to suit the application: solid or slotted walls, two or three runners, four rollers or feet.

These heavy-duty containers can of course also be stacked. The lowest container in the stack can carry 3-4 tonnes.

Stacking Containers for Meat with Transponder

The fact that the Utz Meat Container is not only suitable as a storage and conveyor medium but also exhibits «intelligent» properties is demonstrated by the award of the Innovation Prize 2000 from the Swiss Logistics Association.

Traitafina AG is one of the largest meat processors in Switzerland and has won the coveted prize for its new, fully automated order-picking store and the improved internal logistic process. The order-picking store was equipped with around 30'000 of the newly developed meat containers for internal logistics as well as for customer deliveries. Each container is also fitted with two diagonally-opposed transponders. This ensures faultless storage despite the extreme ambient conditions. Each individual container can be registered, written to, and tracked.

The containers are type EURO 2. As a special feature they have a welded double base which ensures optimum handling on conveyor systems. In addition, floor flexing is minimal with a load of up to 50 kg.

Utz Insulated Boxes are the perfect solution for ensuring an unbroken cold chain when transporting fresh, chilled or frozen foods. They enable the strict requirements set out in food safety legislation to be complied with. Expensive refrigerated trucks are unnecessary for this purpose. Chilled or frozen food – in Utz insulated boxes – are carried together with unchilled products on normal delivery trucks. This cuts distribution costs by up to 55%.



You will be sure to find the right container for your application from among the various sizes and types: the Utz programme contains rugged containers ranging from 600x400 mm base size up to large containers with a base size of 1200x800 mm (pallet size). When used in conjunction with a cold element, chilled or frozen food remains perfectly fresh over many hours.

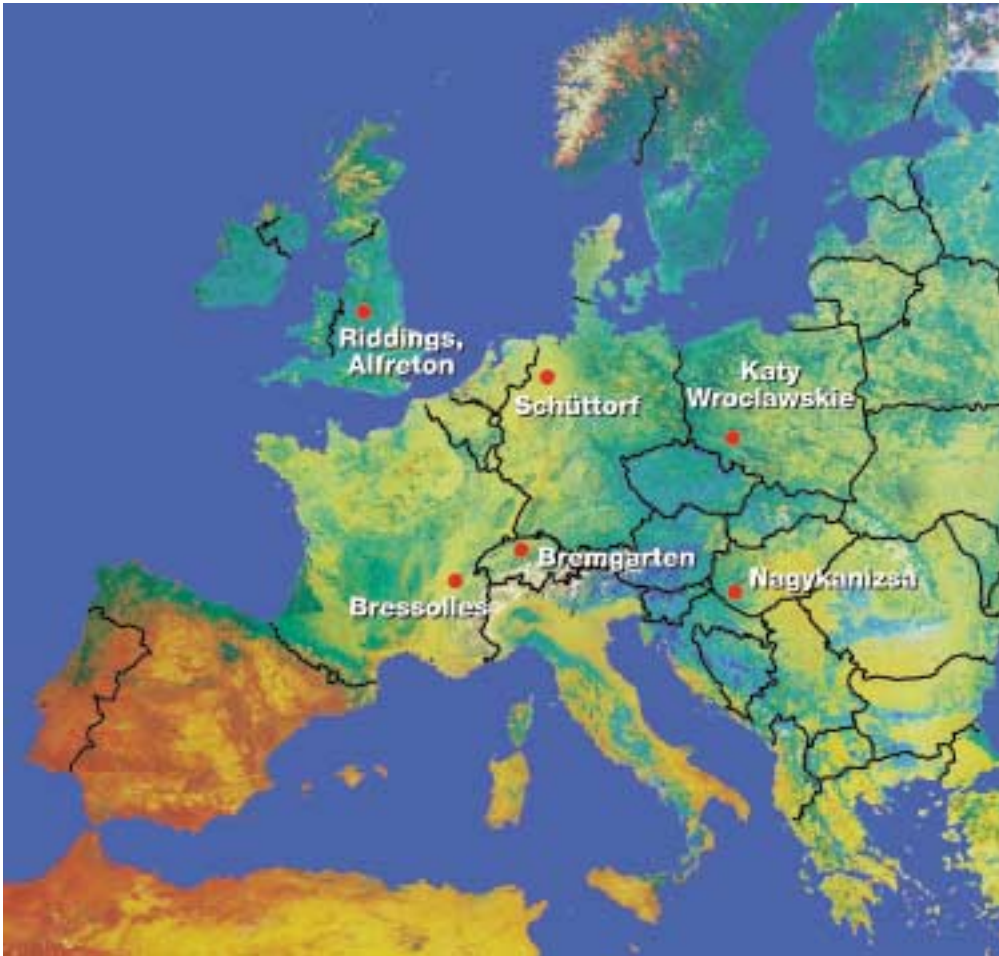
